References list guidelines

- 1) References should appear at the end of the article, in sequential or bibliographic formats, as given in the examples below. References should be numbered in the order in which they are cited.
- 2) Only one style should be used throughout the paper. Authors should avoid ephemeral web links. When available, digital object identifiers (DOIs) are preferred. References to Wikipedia are not permitted.
- 3) Number of references is limited to 60 for literature reviews, and to 20 (as an exception, not less than 10) for original studies and lectures. Do not shorten titles of your citations. Please put an "et al." notation after the third name if cited paper has more than 4 authors.
- 4) References should be chosen carefully and limited to those with a close connection to the manuscript.
